Role

Classes must be taught in accordance with YMCA performance standards for Aquatic Fitness Instructors.

Requirements

- Friendly and outgoing attitude; comfortable in front of a group
- Ability to follow directions and work independently
- Experienced Aquatic Fitness participant or experience teaching land fitness classes
- Report early and in uniform for scheduled volunteer times
- Must participate in orientation and training sessions (including Child Protection Training) as required
- Must be willing to work towards certification as a YMCA Aquatic Fitness Instructor
- Satisfactory Police Records Check and Vulnerable Sector Check within the past 90 days
- Current Standard First Aid and CPR-C

Time Commitment

- 1 class per week for the duration of a session (12 weeks)
- Hours vary based on program schedule
