Build Canada Infrastructure Funding from the Federal and Provincial governments provided the boost the project required. It was time to construct a multi-purpose facility that was financially and physically accessible to all people of all ages.

Today, the Family Y has a new home in the Julie McArthur Regional Recreation Centre. The community hub offers age and ability specific programs. The double ice pad arena, and new Family Y Health and Fitness Facility provide enhanced and improved amenities to better serve the continually changing needs of our community.

The new Family Y comes at a time when cancer and heart disease are the top two killers in Canada<sup>2</sup>, and the life expectancy for children is anticipated to be less than that of their parents<sup>3</sup>. The Family Y rises to the challenge of improving the health of Grey and Bruce with a sense of determination and hope. It is about prevention. It is about getting people active together. It is about promoting health in spirit, mind and body.
