YMCA Secures Grant to Address Lifeguard Shortage, Ensuring Water Safety for Our Community

May 8, 2023 - The YMCA of Owen Sound Grey Bruce is proud to announce that it has been selected to receive a grant from Canadian Tire Jumpstart Charities (Jumpstart). The grant will be used to train candidates to become certified lifeguards and instructors, in order to meet the increasing demand for swimming lessons and promote water safety across the region.

"This funding will allow us to train more lifeguards and instructors, which will enable us to provide high-quality swimming instruction to even more members of our community.

YMCA Steps in to Save Blue Dolphin Pool Season Amid Lifeguard Shortage

May 18, 2023 - Facing a severe shortage of lifeguards, the Meaford community was at risk of losing its public outdoor swimming pool for the season. However, a new agreement with the YMCA of Owen Sound Grey Bruce has averted the closure. Under this partnership, the YMCA will assume full responsibility for the pool's operations, including lifeguard recruitment, training, and programming.



Zehrs Give A Little, Help A Lot Campaign Raises funds for YMCA Financial Assistance Program

July 9, 2023 - From July 9 to July 25, community members generously donated at Owen Sound Zehrs to support their local YMCA. The funds raised helped families of all ages improve their health and well-being through YMCA programs, such as swim lessons, day camp, and youth programming. Thanks to the community's contributions, nearly \$800 was raised in 2023. Together, we made a significant difference in the lives of many.



Partnership with OSAC Shines On

New Kincardine Child Care Opens in St. Anthony's Catholic School

November 1, 2023 - The YMCA of Owen Sound Grey Bruce and the Bruce-Grey Catholic District School Board (BGCDSB) are thrilled to announce the completion of renovations at St. Anthony's Catholic School, allowing the Kincardine YMCA Child Care facility to relocate there on November 1, 2023. Designed to be fully accessible, the new center features controlled access for added security, four spacious rooms with natural light and bathroom facilities, a secure outdoor play area, and designated spaces for strollers and car seats.

Cyndy Jefferson, Director of Child Care at the YMCA of Owen Sound Grey Bruce, states, "We are excited to partner with BGCDSB to open the child care center at St. Anthony's Catholic School. It's designed for young learners to grow, build friendships, and make memories. The new center will offer more safe and affordable child care spaces, much needed in our community." Marylin Dawson, Superintendent of Education at Bruce-Grey Catholic, adds, "Our Catholic schools are truly the heart of the community, and this opening reaffirms our commitment to the Kincardine neighborhood. We look forward to welcoming the students and families who will make it a vibrant place to learn and grow."

The center is licensed for 78 children, including 30 toddlers (an increase of 20 from the former location) and 48 preschoolers. The YMCA Before and After School program is licensed for 26 junior and senior kindergarten students and 60 children from Grade 1 to Grade 6 (12 years of age). A formal opening celebration is planned for the New Year. St. Anthony's School, located at 715 Russell Street, Kincardine, is part of the government's \$14 billion commitment to expand child care.


New Steam Room Unit Installed

Energy Efficient Upgrades

\$46,547 Grant Awarded for Infrastructure Modernization

October 24, 2023 - "With this grant, we can upgrade our computer infrastructure, improving productivity, security, customer service, and data management," said Sarah Cowley, CEO of the YMCA of Owen Sound Grey Bruce.

Since August, the YMCA has installed new security cameras, upgraded 15 computer systems, and implemented a new teleconferencing system. These improvements will greatly benefit staff and community members, supporting the YMCA's mission to build healthy communities.







Fun Run Raises \$6,000 for Strong Communities Fund

April 30th, 2023 - The inaugural Cobble Beach Lighthouse Fun Run, successfully raised \$6,000 for the YMCA's Strong Community financial assistance program.

This program, which last year distributed \$83,000 to support 247 individuals in need, ensures access to health, fitness, and aquatics programs for those facing financial challenges in Grey and Bruce County, where approximately 15% of children and seniors live below the poverty line.

YMCA CEO Sarah Cowley expressed deep gratitude for the donation, highlighting its role in helping the YMCA build healthy communities and make their services accessible to everyone, regardless of financial circumstances. The YMCA looks forward to future events that continue to make a meaningful impact.

The YMCA Saves Lives - Member Story

January 15, 2024 - "Get out of the pool, Bob!" 6 words from Diana, a lifeguard at the YMCA aquatics centre, addressed to me. Those 6 words started a 5-week odyssey that I am not likely to forget.

Just for a little background on me: I swim a kilometer 5 days a week. I consider myself healthy, watching my diet, never smoked, and rarely drink, maybe a glass of wine once in a while. My blood work has always been good. The Veterans Administration in the US takes extremely great care of me. I thought my lifestyle was exemplary and had a long healthy life ahead of me. I had no idea why I was being told to get out of the pool. What ensued was mind-boggling.

This all started on December 5th when I was only about halfway through my laps. Diana and Dianne told me to sit down, and they would call an ambulance. I was very firm that I did not need an ambulance because "I am FINE!" I would go to the locker room and then go home. They called my wife instead, over my protests. They sat with me until my wife arrived. My wife, a nurse of 35 years, arrived and took me straight to the Owen Sound Hospital (Brightshores Health System).



They found several points of concern about my heart, in the echocardiogram and some other tests. I was already scheduled for 2 appointments at the Veterans Administration in Wilmington, DE.

When I got to the Veterans Administration Hospital in Wilmington, DE, they would not do the stress test and sent me to the Cardiologist. He sent me to the Philadelphia Veterans Administration Hospital, who then sent me to the Hospital of the University of Pennsylvania (HUP).

Without giving a whole "ORGAN" recital, they performed 5 critical surgeries. My wife and I were there until January 9th, after the final surgery.

The lifeguards literally saved my life. Based on what the doctor at the OSH saw on the test, I may not have made another length. I owe them my life. Thank you, Diana and Dianne." \sim Bob
