Camp Presqu'ile Family Camp Q&A:

1. I want to share a cabin with another family, how do I do that?

You have two options for signing up here:

- a. Preferred: please only have one family sign up and include both families under that registration, this ensures that only one cabin is reserved. It would then be up to the families to divide the cost of the registrations.
- b. Alternatively, if the first option is not possible, please sign up and indicate by email that you would like to share a space, that will allow us to combine your registration and avoid taking up an additional cabin for your group.

2. What does programming look like at Family Camp?

Family Camp programming is designed to be enjoyed at your own pace. Presqu'ile staff will run program areas throughout the day that parents and children can drop into as they'd like. We ask that only program areas that have a staff member at them be used by families unless otherwise indicated.

3. Can you accommodate my dietary restrictions/allergies?

We can accommodate most food restrictions as long as we know in advance. We cannot accommodate a kosher diet but can accommodate halal and most allergens. If we have a very specific diet you follow you are also welcome to bring food with you.

4. Is there transportation to camp?

No, we do not provide any transportation to camp and each family is responsible for transporting themselves to and from camp.

5. Is there Wi-fi at camp?

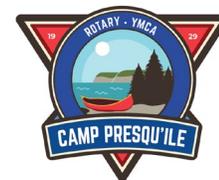
We have wi-fi at camp but our connection is rural so will not be available to family camp participants. If you require internet for an emergency please speak to a staff member but we encourage you to put your electronics away and enjoy an unplugged experience while at camp.

6. Can I bring my dog?

While we love dogs at camp we ask that you leave your furry family members at home. There are two other camp dogs you can give a pet and a cuddle to during your time with us.

7. What are the accommodations like?

Each family is assigned to a cabin of their own. Cabins are outfitted with single beds with vinyl covered foam mattresses. Please bring your own linens (sheets and blankets or sleeping bags), pillows, towels, etc. Each cabin has electricity. Washrooms are located in two centralized buildings around camp which are cleaned several times each day.

8. I can't add a primary adult cabin reservation to a family camp booking, what do I do?

This may be because you do not have an age associated with your account. You will need to go back to the main menu and ensure there is an age attached to your profile.

9. I want to add more people to my booking after signing up, how do I do that?

Send us an email to presquile@osgb.ymca.ca, we will be happy to help add more people to your booking. Once the additional charges are added, we will ask you to sign back into your account and edit your family info form to include the new family members.

10. Why can't I add a primary adult booking to my cabin reservation? What can I do?

This may mean that all the cabin reservations have been reserved and there is no longer space for you to sign up. If this happens, send us an email, we may be able to make something work! Also consider sharing a cabin if you have a friend that has already signed up and would be happy to have you stay with them!
